If the installation is done properly, there should not be any problem.

" should the edges be bull nosed? ―

They should be bullnosed, no doubt. Also, there should be minimal overhang $\hat{a} \in \hat{}$ if any. In other words, the risers should be almost flush with the edges of the steps.
