I highly recommend that you decline the job.
First off, unless you're extremely proficient at doing stone restoration, there's no way that you could do the job right †not to mention that it would cost dramatically more than buying new tiles. Second (of perhaps first againâ€!) it is a totall dumb idea to use polished travertine in a fountain: the polish will last no more than a few weeks.
