Dear Susanne:

The description of your problem is scarce to say the least. I will try to guess.

Are you perhaps making reference to a few holes in your marble that have to be filled and they're talking about epoxy or polyester filler?

Or are you talking about a travertine floor and they're perhaps talking about specific filler called "Travefill"?

Whatever that is, if it is polyester filler or epoxy and you're concerned for your pets, keep them out of the house until they're finished using it.
