Dear Diana: " Do you need a water barrer under granite? ― No. " Do you glue tops onto plywood or float on a thinset? ― I prefer to glue it, but just with a few dabs of glue here and there (and the right glue: 100% silicone or epoxy). Be cause of the difference in expansion value between the two materials I don't like full contact bonding. " Can you lay island top on plywood without gluing or thinset? ― By all means.
