The fabricator I have found will rod (re-inforce) the counter with the sink cutouts but not the rest... is this acceptable? And I will insist that they do not seal the stone, which means all I need is MB 5 for regular cleaning. Is this right? Lastly - do you ever come to Texas? :-)
