Very beautiful. We did the lemon juice test on 2 samples and they did not discolor. However they seem to scratch very easily in the silver part of the stone. I'm assuming that these samples are not sealed. Do you know about this granite and would it be good for kitchen counters? If so, will sealing help against the scratching?
