Dear Katryna:

Unfortunately there's no such thing like a "best stone― for a problematic situation like yours. Travertine, being a calcareous rock, is among the least appropriate.

Very dark "granite―, like black absolute, Volga blue, pewter, etc. may fit the bill, but… You may want to consider ceramic tiles.
