Q. Is epoxy or urethanes the best choice to seal the surface of hand painted travertine tiles? They were painted with Windsor & Newton fine oil paints and some Miniwax brown oil stains.

A. Well, that depends on a few things like what the location is and how large is the area. I dont have enough info to make an informed answer. If you are looking to protect the paint then probably it is a good choice, but make sure the carriers of the epoxies don't why even seal it if you can find a safe cleaner.
