Maurizio, I made a mistake in a rush and got bathroom cleaner on my marble floor. I can not feel any roughness but can definitely see dull spots where the cleaner sat for about 30 seconds. What can I do to bring the shine back to my polished marble?

Dear John:

You could try with MB-11 before calling in a professional stone refinisher. Just bear in mind that bathroom cleaners are *really* nasty sons of guns and even if the product has been sitting on the stone surface for "only" 30 seconds, depending on the marble the damage may be beyond MB-11's abilities. :-(
