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Hello, I found something called Jerusalem tile and like it very much but was under the impression it is travertine. Upon researching further it appears to be a type of limestone. I Can someone tell me which type of stone this is? Thanks

Dear Naomi:

Despite the fact that many limestones would be a total disaster in a shower stall, Jerusalem limestone (not a travertine) is one of the best limestones available. Yes, it can be used successfully for the purpose, providing that it's installed properly (many setters don't install stall right) and that you get the right intelligence on how to care for it.
