Is it necessary to seal the underside of granite tiles before intallation? My experience is that the thinset shows through after installation so I am hoping sealing the underside will address this. Dear Gennadiy:

" I am hoping sealing the underside will address this."

No it will not. Even the best impregnator will let the moisture of the setting material through. Impregnators only give you reaction time, never 100% sealing.
