dark spots on limestone shower

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We had limestone installed in our shower several months ago. It was sealed prior to use. Now, I am noticing that the bottom portions of the stone at the base of the shower appear to be getting darker. How do I fix this? Thanks, Ann

Dear Ann:

Ah, limestone in a shower stallâ€l Ain't it beautiful?!... Not too smart, maybe, but beautiful nonethelessâ€l

It sounds to me like you have water under your stall floor tiles. Check all the grout lines and see if some of it is missing or cracked. If so, considering that your stall is only a few months old, it can probably be rescued, providing that the installer did not set the tiles butt-jointed. (In such case, the image of a jack-hammer crosses my mind†L)

Do this:

- Στιχκ σινήλε σηέετο οφ Βουντψ πάπερ τοωέλ ιν τηε ήρουτ λίνε, πυσηίνη τηεμ ήεντλψ ασ δεέπ ασ ποσσίβλε. Βουντψ βρανδ ισ τηε βέστ. Τηε σέχονδ βέστ ισ ςίδα. Αλλ τηε ρέστ ισ πάρβαμε. Ψου ωίλλ προβαβλψ σεέ ωατέρ ωίχκινη υπ τηρουήη τηε πάπερ τοωέλ ιν τηε λόωερ πάρτο οφ τηε στάλλ, εσπεχιαλλψ τηε φλόορ.
- Είν ιφ ανδ ωπέν της πάπερ τοωέλ δοές νότ σεέμ το αβσορβ ανψτηίνς, λέαις ιτ τηέρε φορ ατ λέαστ α χουπλέ οφ ωεέκς. Α μοντή ορ σο ωουλδ βέ βέστ. Κέεπ της δοόρ οφ ψούρ σταλλ όπεν αλλ της τίμε.
 - Ρε-γρουτ τηορουγηλψ.
 - Λετ τηε γρουτ χυρε φορ α φεω δαψσ.
 - Ψου χαν νοω υσε ψουρ σηοωερ σταλλ αγαιν!
