Dry the colour is very gray but the colour wet is black which I want. Is there any product I can buy eg. a sealer which will give a "permanent wet look" to black limestone. Thanks Mark

Dear Mark

A good-quality stone color enhancer like MB-6 could be the answer to your quest.

Keep in mind, however, that black limestone in general is not the best selection for outdoor installations; therefore you may eventually have problems down the road that are strictly related to the suitability of the stone, and no miracle in a bottle will ever be able to make up for the lack of specific (stone) intelligence...
