## **Travertine Floor Tiles**

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Hi Maurizio Have just had travertine tiles installed in the kitchen and they have been sealed. I have tried to wash them several times with brush, water and mild soap but the tiles still have smears and marks ALL OVER them. I must that I am dealing with shoddy workmen! Please help! Anne Moedbeck

Dear Anne:

Well, unless you live in great state of New Jersey, how do you figure that I could possibly help you??...

Removing the residue of cured-on impregnator (a.k.a. sealer) ain't no easy feat! And the best way to go about it is by professionally re-honing your floor with a good-quality honing-powder. This assuming that your travertine is hone-finished (you don't specify).

If it is polished instead, re-polishing it with a good-quality polishing powder for marble should do the trick.

No matter what, it's going to cost you a pretty penny, but you should be demanding your "shoddy workmen― to pick up the tab for the mess they created. Go to the find a pro section on <a href="www.stoneandtilepros.com">www.stoneandtilepros.com</a> and find a stone restoration contractor near you.
