Dear Kevin:

Nobody could ever seal Emperador. It's just too darn dense! Add to that big advantage the fact that's dolostone (not as sensitive to pH active substabces as calcareous marbles and limestones), and you have a winner for your stall! Just in case I didn't read you right, you're going to have a 1/16" grout gap in between tiles inside the stall, right?...
