Dear Myriam:

It's an easy answer and, alas, sad at the same time. Somehow water found its way behind and under your tiles and that is what causing the loosening of the tiles, their discoloration and their rotting away.

Going by your description of the situation it sounds like it's too far gone to try to do anything, but you may want to consult with a proficient stone restoration contractor in your area before getting ahold of that jack-hammer!
