Please help me to clean the White Antique grout! We did the renovation a year ago, but the company was bad, we had to do a lot of work ourselves. Now the grout is dirty in some places, I've tried the bleach, but it didn't work. How can I clean between the tiles without damaging it and without reinstalling the new grout?

Dear Yelena:

Sorry, but no can do: I don't do contracting work any moreâ€! J

I was about to suggest you to use a heavy-duty grout cleaner like MB-2, but if the bleach didn't do anything, then maybe the â€œdirtâ€• that you have is some deeply embedded staining. If you could get some grout of the same color, your best bet would be to scrape the stained areas to a depth of approximately 1/8â€• with a grout scraping too that's available at any tile retail store or a Big Box store, and the re-fill with new grout.
