J However, if you plan to use your stovetop intensively, I wouldn't list that material among my favorite. It's kinda too delicate to expose to steam and splatters; it will lose its polish within months. That said, the stone is too dense to be sealed; so, no sealing before or after grouting will ever be possible. As for its routine care, the same products that you will be using for your countertop (MB-5 and MB-13) will be perfect for it.
