I have an Italian marble statue that has been outdoors for many years. How can I clean it? Thank you very much for your help. Eric

Dear Eric:

You can use a powerful alkaline stone cleaner formulated for the removal of biological soil (mildew and mold) rated "for natural stone― like MB-9. Spray it on liberally and let it do most the work. It may take several minutes. Repeat if necessary, and, in the most stubborn areas, help the products with a medium bristle laundry-brush. Rinse thoroughly with a hose when finished and let it dry. Done!
